



Executive Regulation n. 328 on the December 22, 2010

Leeway supportive housing Notice to the benefit of immigrant citizens – Year 2010/2011.

On implementation of the Municipal Committee Resolution n. 1502 of 17/09/2009, and also of the Municipal Committee Resolution n. 1149 of the 30th July 2010, an Invitation to bid is proclaimed to provide a grant in behalf of citizens:

- A) Non – EU Citizen;
- B) Roma community EU Citizen;
- C) Refugees and grant in aid or humanitarian protection holder;
- D) Asylum seeker;
- E) Admitted with priority are foreign citizens hosted in temporary facilities offered in emergency cases by the Municipality and in posses of these prerequisites:
 - 1. Family unit residency on the 1st September 2009 with priority on the state of default of the family unit;
 - 2. Uttered and final renunciation of a temporary accommodation arranged by the City of Naples.

This notice allows to compete for the benefit :

- 1. accommodation aid supply with a grant for the rental payment;

RESOURCES

Granting resources are assigned to the Prefecture of the City of Naples – financial year 2008 section 2351 regarding the Home Office funds – Department for Civil Liberties and Immigration.

BID REQUIREMENTS

Individuals and family units are allowed to participate to the bid and to request a grant if on the application date are in posses of these requirements:

- a) persons in particular social disadvantage (non-EU citizens, refugees and grant in aid or humanitarian protection holder, asylum seeker);
- b) Rental agreement holder, for a building located in the City of Naples, regularly registered, even underwritten subsequent the publication date of this notice, provided that such an agreement has not been stipulated between family and extended family within the 2nd degree of kinship, or rather, to stipulate a rental agreement for use as dwelling, regularly registered, for an accommodation, only located in the City of Naples, by and no later than 60 days, from the admittance communication date to this bid;
- c) No proprietary right holder, usufruct, use or dwelling for accommodation/s or parts of them, located in the City of Naples;

- d) For asylum seeker owning a valid permit of stay or an equivalent certificate;
- e) For non-EU citizens , refugees and grant in aid or humanitarian protection holder , owning a valid permit of stay or renewal receipt, an ID card, a valid ISEE notification (Legislative Decree 130/00 and Prime Ministerial Decree 242/01) or an equivalent certificate, resulting an ISEE-fsa (Equivalent Financial Condition Indicator regarding the Rental Supply Fund) not higher than € 7,500;
- f) For Roma community EU citizens , exclusively within Prefecture census, owning an ID card, ethnic group membership certificate, place of residence;

The grant will be withdrawn in case of fail of one requirement.

Foreign citizens will be admitted de jure to the grant if they are already hosted in temporary facilities arranged in emergency cases by the Municipality, owning the subsequent prerequisites:

- a) family unit residence on the date 1st September 2009 with priority on the numerousness of the family unit;
- b) Uttered and final renunciation of a temporary accommodation arranged by the City of Naples;

The accommodation regarding the grant shall be included in the cadastral categories A/2, A/3,A/4,A/5,A/6,A/7 and A/11.

In case of sharing of a dwelling of more individuals or family units only one grant request will be admitted by an individual or a unit as a rental agreement holder or as succeeded as provided or as juridical measure

The housing accommodation area shall correspond to the one provided by the regulation in force on the Residential Council Housing (L.R.C. n. 18/97).

The length of the request shall be up to 12 months, for existing agreement as well as for new ones, according to the above mentioned requirements.

This grant can't be combined with another rental supply grant.

TERMS AND CONDITION FOR THE APPLICATION

The requests can be submitted at Servizio Assegnazione Immobili (Housing Allocation Service) – Piazza Cavour n. 42 – 80137 – Naples (for the language modalities download the application on the www.immigraতিestranieri.it) **from the 17th January 2011 up to the 17th March 2011.**

The applicant can refer to the URP counters of the City of Naples to fill out the application in order to avoid mistakes and the subsequent civil or criminal penalties.

For the *rental grant* the supply has been fixed to a maximum of 80% on the monthly sum of the rental agreement and anyhow to the amount up to 250 € per month for 12 months.

The applications will be examined by an appropriate internal Committee of the Housing Allocation Service of the City of Naples which will produce a classification under the criterions of the subsequent table:

EVALUATION CRITERIA (for the applicants on the articles A),B),C),D)).

| City of Naples Residence | 2 points |
| Executive eviction | Up to 5 assigned under the eviction reasons: - safety reasons 5 points - end of lease 3 points - arrears 2 points |
| Lack of accommodation period | Up to 5 points (1 point each semester). |

| Temporary unemployment | Up to 5 points (1 point each semester). |
| Financial capacity | Up to 5 points (in ascending order from the lower income which assignment is 5 points). |

The Committee has the faculty to request explanations, additional documentation and any other element assumed as needful to produce the classification.

The grant qualified person, after an invitation by the *Housing Allocation Service*, has to submit, to avoid forfeiture, the documentation in confirmation of the notice requirements.
